2018-2019 RICFE ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

One scholarship of \$2,000.00 will be awarded to a qualified student meeting the following criteria: Applicants must be matriculating full-time undergraduate or graduate students pursuing a degree at an accredited Rhode Island college or university with a declared major in accounting, criminal justice, criminology, law or law enforcement. Other majors will be considered on a case-by-case basis, as they relate to the anti-fraud profession. High school students and past scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply. These scholarships are awarded by the Rhode Island Chapter’s Educational Outreach and Scholarship Committee on the basis of academic achievement, application essay and references. Application Deadline is **June 30, 2018**. The scholarship award will be announced no later than **August 15, 2018** and awarded at the Annual RI CFE Excellence Awards in **September 2018**.
